Thank you for booking a MGOL workshop.

Equipment

Betsy will be bringing a Mac laptop and a dongle for VGA (blue wire) connections. If your projector uses a different (HDMI or DVI) connection, please provide a backup laptop or the appropriate dongle.

- LED Projector
- Cable to connect projector to laptop
- Extension cord (if needed)
- Other wires (if needed)
- Screen with white background to project on
- Lapel Mic (only needed for large audiences)
- Bottled Water
- Flannel Board Easel

This is an **essential piece of equipment** because of the shelf in the middle.

If you do not already own one, it is a worthwhile purchase.

The "Best-Rite" or "Quartet" wooden easel is less expensive, but the metal one has wheels.

They are both sturdy. (see pictures below!) Make sure they come with the inside shelf!



Craft Supplies:

- Different colors of felt squares (one square per person minimum, preferably 2-4 per person.)
- Tacky Glue (*can be found in fabric stores - for gluing felt on felt*)
A bunch of small bottles works best.
- Scissors that can cut felt
- Permanent Markers (*only a few of these are needed*)
- Googly eyes (OPTIONAL)
- Plain paper, pens, and pencils (OPTIONAL)

Books to pull from your collection (or borrow from someone else's) for use in the workshop.
