Quick checklist for MGOL workshop

Thank you for booking a MGOL workshop.

Equipment

- LED Projector
- Cable to connect projector to laptop
- Extension cord (if needed) \bigcirc
- \bigcirc Other wires (if needed)
- Screen \bigcirc
- \bigcirc Lapel Mic (only needed for large audiences)
- \bigcirc CD Player OR Speakers and sound system
- \bigcirc Bottled Water (for the speaker)
- \bigcirc Flannel Board Easel
 - This is an **essential piece of equipment** because of the shelf in the middle.

If you do not already own one, it is a worthwhile purchase.

- You can buy them online by searching for "flannel board easel."
- The wooden by ("Best-Rite" or "Quartet" is less expensive, but the metal one has wheels. They are both sturdy. (see pictures below!) Make sure they come with the inside shelf!



Craft Supplies:

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- Different colors of felt squares (one square per person minimun, preferably 2-4 per person.)
- Tacky Glue (can be found in fabric stores for gluing felt on felt) \bigcirc A bunch of small bottles works best.
- Scissors that can cut felt
- Permanent Markets (only a few of these are needed)
- Googly eyes (OPTIONAL)
- \bigcirc Plain paper, pens, and pencils (OPTIONAL)

MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS AND PROPS

Betsy has all of the following items, and can bring them in large enough quantities for all participants. However, some locations prefer to buy the items in order to have them for their MGOL programs, or prefer to use the instruments they already own. So please let us know if you will be supplying the instruments of if Betsy should bring them. Thank you!

- Bells: Our favorite bells are Easy-Grip Jingle Bells in animal shapes and different colors, which can be purchased through www.lakeshorelearning.com One bell for each participant
- Rhythm Sticks: These should be 6-8" long, painted or with a natural wood finish. Inexpensive sticks can be found at http://www.kimboed.com/rhythmsticks612sets.aspx Alternately, you can buy dowels and have them cut to size and sanced. One pair for each participant
- Maracas: Small maracas (also called "chickitas") should be sturdy, non-toxic, and washable. Search online for LP RhythMix Chickitas or buy an 18 pair bulk pack from www.littlehandsmusic.com One pair for each participant
- Drum or Tambourine: Choose one that can be easily carried and has a top that can be tapped.

Only one for the presenter is needed

- Colored Scarves: Scarves that are translucent are great for playing peek-a-boo with young children; they aren't scary since the children can see through them. We recommend the Rhythm Band package of 12 scarves, which can be purchased at: www. Musiciansfriend.com/classroom-kids/rhythm-band-12-colored-scarves One scarf for each participant
- Farm Animals: Three different farm animals puppets or stuffed animals for the presenter to use (i.e. horse. sheep, cow). Long-lasting life-like hand puppets are available at www.folkmanis.com but they are not inexpensive!
 A minimum of three farm animal puppets are needed.

Please be reassured that Betsy has all of the above books, musical instruments, and props, and can bring them to the workshop. We will contact you one week before the workshop

to find out which items you will supply and which one Betsy should bring, AND

to ask how many people will be attending the workshop (so we will know how many instruments to bring).
